



Bernie Heard Memorial Bursary (\$1000)

Background

Bernie Heard was an active member of NunatuKavut (formerly Labrador Metis Nation) who passed away in January of 2008. He served as both the Vice President and Interim President for a period, and is very much missed in Labrador. Bernie was a great musician and especially loved to perform music from his culture. He was also very active in historical and genealogy research and his work contributed greatly to the foundation of our membership systems.

In memoriam, NCC will administer a Bursary which has been donated by a member. Application is not limited to, but preference will be given to students studying in the areas of Music and History. Other areas of priority consideration may include visual and performing arts, anthropology and archeology.

Eligibility

- Be a current member of NunatuKavut
- Be enrolled in full time studies (generally 4 courses or more) at a Government recognized university or college
- If applicable, successfully completed and passed the previous semester of post-secondary studies.
- Maintained at least a 60% cumulative average
- Priority consideration given to students not receiving other forms of funding from NunatuKavut

Application Process

- Provide an essay outlining their decision making process for their career choice and their need for the scholarship.
- Provide three reference letters from employers, teachers or community leaders
- A copy of their final high school transcript and post-secondary cumulative grades if applicable
- Completed Student Information Sheet (can be downloaded at www.nunatukavut.ca under "Find a form or application")

Applications must be received at NCC on or before **August 31, 2018**.
