



Raymond Turnbull Memorial Bursary (\$2000)

Background

Raymond Turnbull grew up in Charlottetown, Labrador. He went on to pursue a degree in education and later taught at the school in Charlottetown. Raymond came to the NunatuKavut Community Council (NCC) as the Education Officer where he dedicated his life to helping Indigenous youth. Sadly, Raymond passed away in 2004, leaving a void in the hearts of his family, friends and colleagues.

In his memory and honour, NCC is administering a Raymond Turnbull Memorial Bursary, valued at \$2000.00. This bursary is awarded annually to a NCC member who is graduating from Level III and who has demonstrated admirable community and school involvement as well as academic achievement.

Eligibility

- Successful completion of Level III in 2019
- Enrolling in their first semester of Post-Secondary education in 2019
- Current member of NCC

Application Process

Applicants must provide:

- A completed Student Information Sheet (can be downloaded at www.nunatukavut.ca under "Find a form or application")
- A short essay on future goals and aspirations and why you feel you are a good candidate for this Bursary
- Three reference letters (Principal/Teacher, Community Group/Council Leader, Employer)
- A copy of their final high school transcript
