PHASE 2 COVID-19 VACCINATIONS STARTING FOR INDIGENOUS ADULTS IN NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR

MARCH 24, 2020

The Province of Newfoundland and Labrador is preparing to offer the COVID-19 vaccine to adults who identify as Indigenous as part of Phase 2 of the province's COVID-19 Immunization Plan. This includes members of the NunatuKavut Community Council (NCC). It is important to note that vaccine roll-out across the four regional health authorities will vary. Details on booking your vaccine appointment through Labrador-Grenfell (LG) Health and other regional health authorities is outlined below. This is based on information provided by LG Health and the Province.

LG HEALTH

Beginning March 29th, the COVID-19 vaccine will be available to Indigenous adults living in communities in the LG Health service area.
