



FIREWOOD HEAT SECURITY FORM

The Firewood Heat Security Program is being introduced by the NunatuKavut Community Council (NCC) in response to the COVID-19 global pandemic. This program provides one cord of firewood per household for NunatuKavut seniors aged 63+ and vulnerable. You must be living in Upper Lake Melville, the Straits, or in the communities of Cartwright, Paradise River, Charlottetown, Norman Bay, Pinsent’s Arm, Port Hope Simpson, St. Lewis, Mary’s Harbour or Lodge Bay.

There are limited cords of firewood available, and it will be distributed on a first come-first serve basis.

Eligibility

Eligible applicants include NunatuKavut members who:

- Are age 63 or older;
- Have a disability; or
- Receive Income Support (Social Assistance); and
- Applicants who have not accessed the COVID-19 heat security voucher (for electricity or heating fuel) will be given priority.
