



Marshall Industries Ltd. Bursary (\$1000)

Background

In March 2026, Nunacor Development Corporation, the business development arm of the NunatuKavut Community Council (NCC), entered into a strategic partnership with Marshall Industries Ltd., a Labrador-based leader in industrial, construction, and maintenance services. This partnership brings together Marshall Industries' extensive industrial experience and Nunacor's commitment to economic development, creating opportunities to support regional projects while advancing sustainable growth and employment within NunatuKavut communities.

As part of this partnership, NCC is pleased to administer the Marshall Industries Ltd. Bursary, valued at \$1,000 annually. The bursary will be awarded to an NCC member who is enrolled in a trades program, or planning to enroll in a recognized post-secondary institution and has demonstrated strong academic achievement.

Eligibility

- Current member of NCC
- Enrolled in full-time studies (generally four courses or more) at a government-recognized university or college
- If applicable, successful completion and passing of the previous semester of post-secondary studies
- Priority consideration will be given to NCC members who have chosen to pursue careers in a trades program such as; welding, millwright, construction/Industrial electrician, etc.

Application Process

Applicants must provide:

- A completed ESD Student Information Sheet
- A short essay on future goals and aspirations and why you feel you are a good candidate for this Bursary
- One reference letter (i.e. Principal/Teacher, Community Group/Council Leader, Employer, etc.)
- A copy of final high school transcript or latest post-secondary cumulative grades, if applicable
