



## Quadra Chemicals Bursary (\$1000)

### Background

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In August 2024, Nunacor Development Corporation, the business development arm of the NunatuKavut Community Council (NCC), entered into a strategic partnership with Quadra Chemicals, one of Canada's largest Canadian-owned chemical distributors and a recognized industry leader. This partnership combines Quadra's technical and industry experience with Nunacor's commitment to economic development, creating new opportunities to expand products and services for the mining and industrial sectors while supporting sustainable growth within NunatuKavut communities.

As part of this partnership, NCC is pleased to administer the Quadra Minerals Bursary, valued at \$1,000 annually. The bursary will be awarded to an NCC member who is enrolled, or planning to enroll, in post-secondary education and has demonstrated strong academic achievement, with preference given to students pursuing studies in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) disciplines.

### Eligibility

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- Current member of NCC
- Enrolled in full-time studies (generally four courses or more) at a government-recognized university or college
- If applicable, successful completion and passing of the previous semester of post-secondary studies
- Priority consideration will be given to NCC members who have chosen to pursue careers in STEM related sectors.

### Application Process

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Applicants must provide:

- A completed ESD Student Information Sheet
- A short essay on future goals and aspirations and why you feel you are a good candidate for this Bursary
- One reference letter (i.e. Principal/Teacher, Community Group/Council Leader, Employer, etc.)
- A copy of final high school transcript or latest post-secondary cumulative grades, if applicable.
